Providing financial assistance

Further Information for couples (including those considering coming with children)

The DE (Destiny Encounter) has always been open to both the single and the married. But as an organisation, we feel compelled this time round to make it even more accessible to married couples. So, for the 2022 DE, we will be offering special couples' sessions for those married and/or those engaged to be married within 3months of the DE. This is in addition to the normal DE sessions.

Furthermore, we will be offering a substantial discount for couples who are coming for a week or more. As a general principle, we will not offer discount to couples who have not completed the round2 application process

Couples coming with children

Couples are going to be offered en-suite rooms with some additional discounts to help reduce the costs so that they are not burdened. The discount will be offered after the Round2 application process has been completed by aspiring delegates.

We will also be providing creche and kids activities so that couples with young children can be released to join the sessions without the need to provide 24hrs care to their kids. We would advise that *Water from the Rock* is not specifically structured to provide any form of care to children. As a result, what we are offering is help (in the form of baby-sitting for those with young children). Our volunteers ofcourse would be vetted to ensure they comply with very basic safeguarding regulations for working with children.

Please be aware that each couple can only have a maximum of two kids coming with them, and they must be under the age of 5years old.
